The unemployment rate declined from 7.3 percent to 7.0 percent in November, and total nonfarm payroll employment rose by 203,000. Employment increased in transportation and warehousing, health care, and manufacturing.

05**October jobless rates down over the year in 280 of 372 metro areas; payroll jobs up in 288**

Jobless rates were lower in October than a year earlier in 280 of the 372 metropolitan areas, higher in 79, and unchanged in 13. Nonfarm payroll employment was up in 288 metropolitan areas over the year, down in 75, and unchanged in 9.
