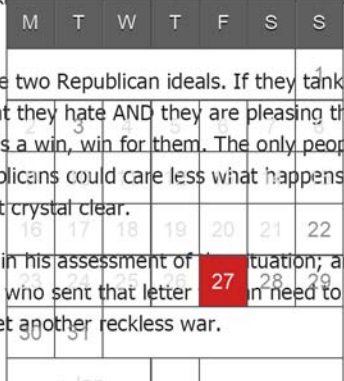
that money. Why else would they be giving it to them?
