American troops secretly reported finding more than 4,990 chemical munitions, according to interviews with dozens of participants, Iraqi and American officials and to heavily redacted intelligence documents obtained under the Freedom of Information Act.

Chemical Rounds Found in 2006 (p. 29)

In the first nine months of 2006 alone, United States forces in Iraq recovered more than 750 chemical rounds, according to the internal military data obtained by The New York Times under the Freedom on Information Act and to officials with knowledge of the formerly classified tallies.
