

State Department official arrested for allegedly soliciting sex from a minor

WASHINGTON - A senior State Department official has been arrested for allegedly soliciting sex from a minor, <u>according to FOX News</u>.

Fairfax County police say 44-year-old Daniel Rosen was arrested at his D.C. home after he allegedly attempted to arrange sex with a person he thought was a minor, but was actually communicating online with an officer in the county's Child Exploitation Unit posing as a minor.

Rosen has been charged with one count of Use of a Communications Device to Solicit a Juvenile.

He is the director of counterterrorism programs and policy at the State Department.

A State Department spokesperson told FOX News, "We are aware that a State Department employee has been arrested and charges have been issued.

"For issues related to Department personnel and for privacy reasons, we are not able to confirm the identity of the individual or specific charges.

"His security clearance will be suspended and he will be put on administrative leave while this proceeds to its end through any judicial process. We are following standard procedure in this case."
