## Occupy Wall St To Stay In Zucotti, Cleanup Delayed

NEW YORK -- Occupy Wall Street, the group of protesters who have been demonstrating in New York City's Zucotti Park, will remain in the park indefinitely after the city and Brookfield Properties, the park's owner, postponed a planned cleanup of the area on Friday morning. New York Deputy Mayor Cas Holloway said in a statement on Friday morning that Brookfield notified the city late Thursday night that it was postponing the cleanup and that it believed it, "can work out an arrangement with the protesters that will ensure the park remains clean, safe, available for public use and that the situation is respectful of residents and businesses downtown, and we will continue to monitor the situation." The protesters have been living in the park for almost a month.
