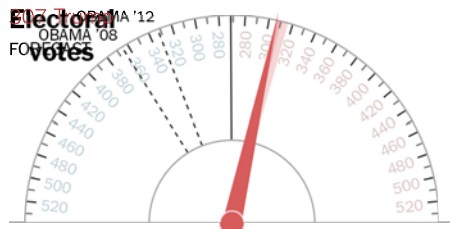
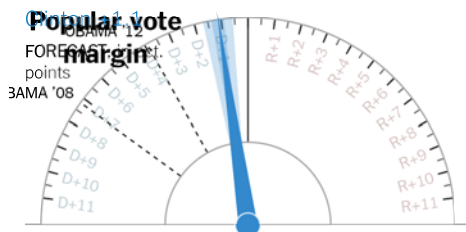
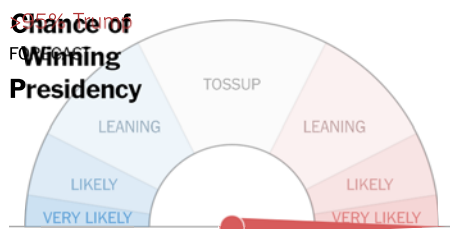

The projections for each state are based on the votes reported so far and how those places have voted in previous elections.

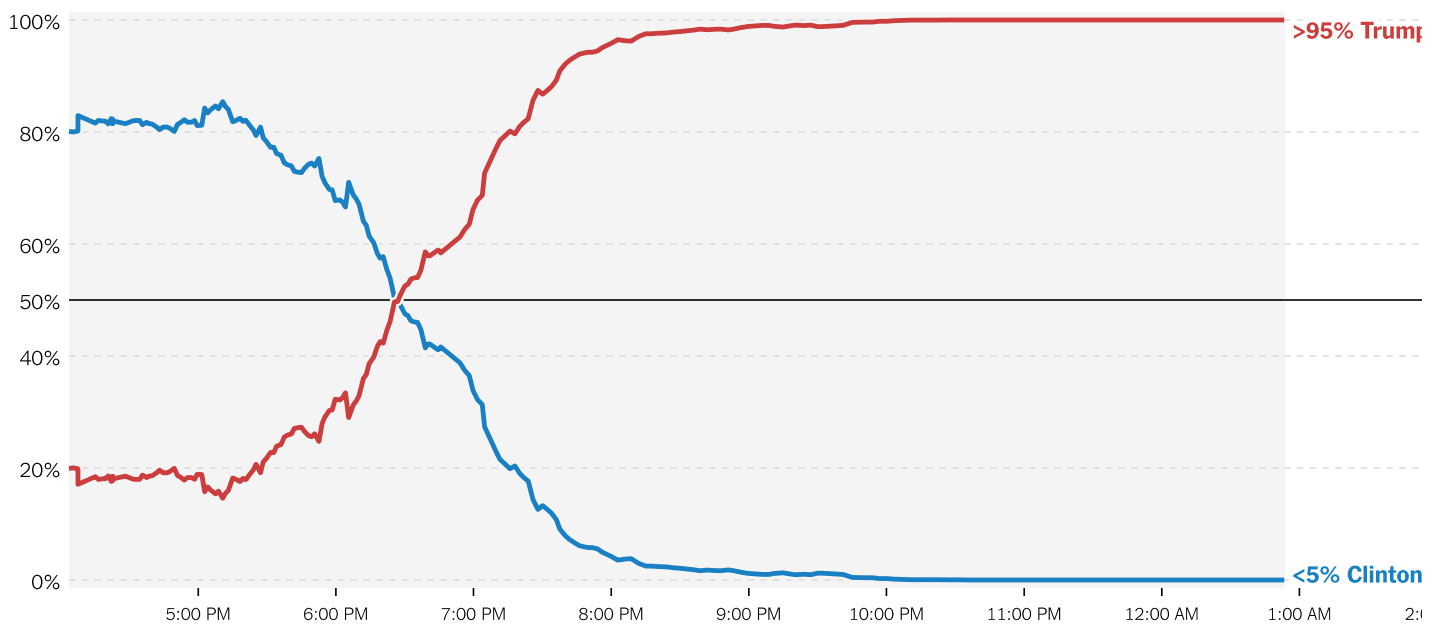

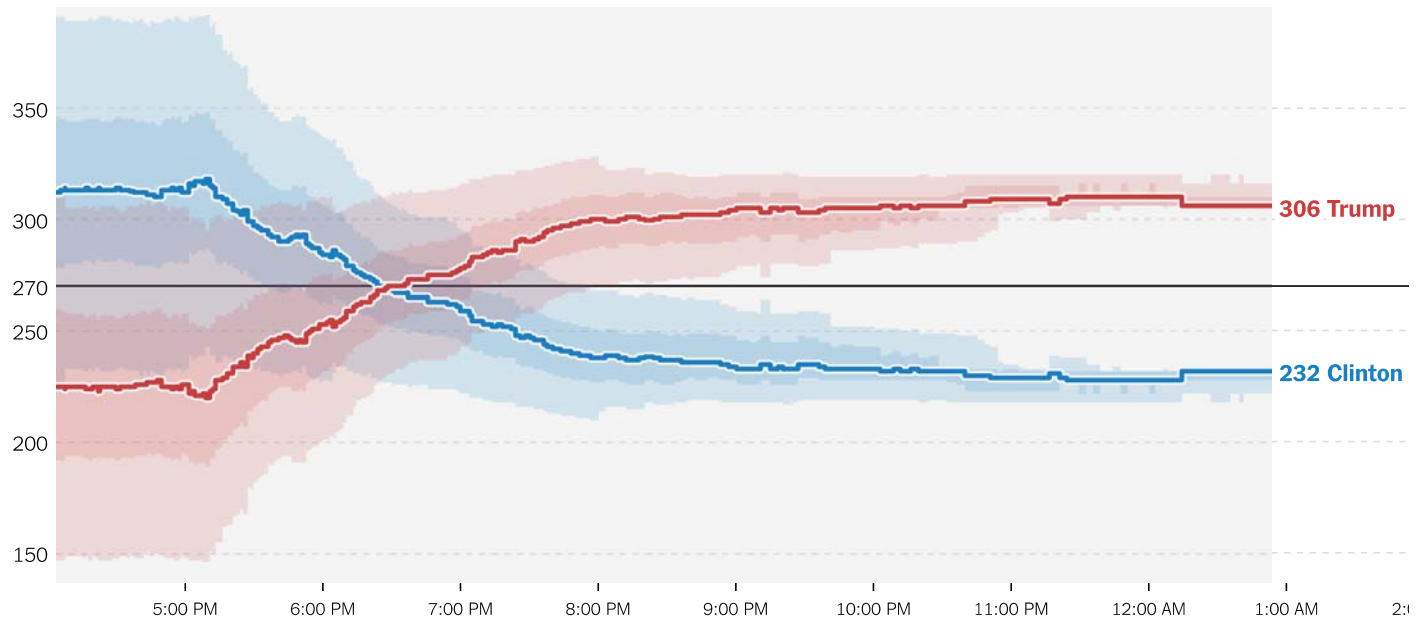
Chance of Winning Presidency

The estimates below include an estimate of uncertainty. We expect the uncertainty around these estimates to narrow, especially after races are called.

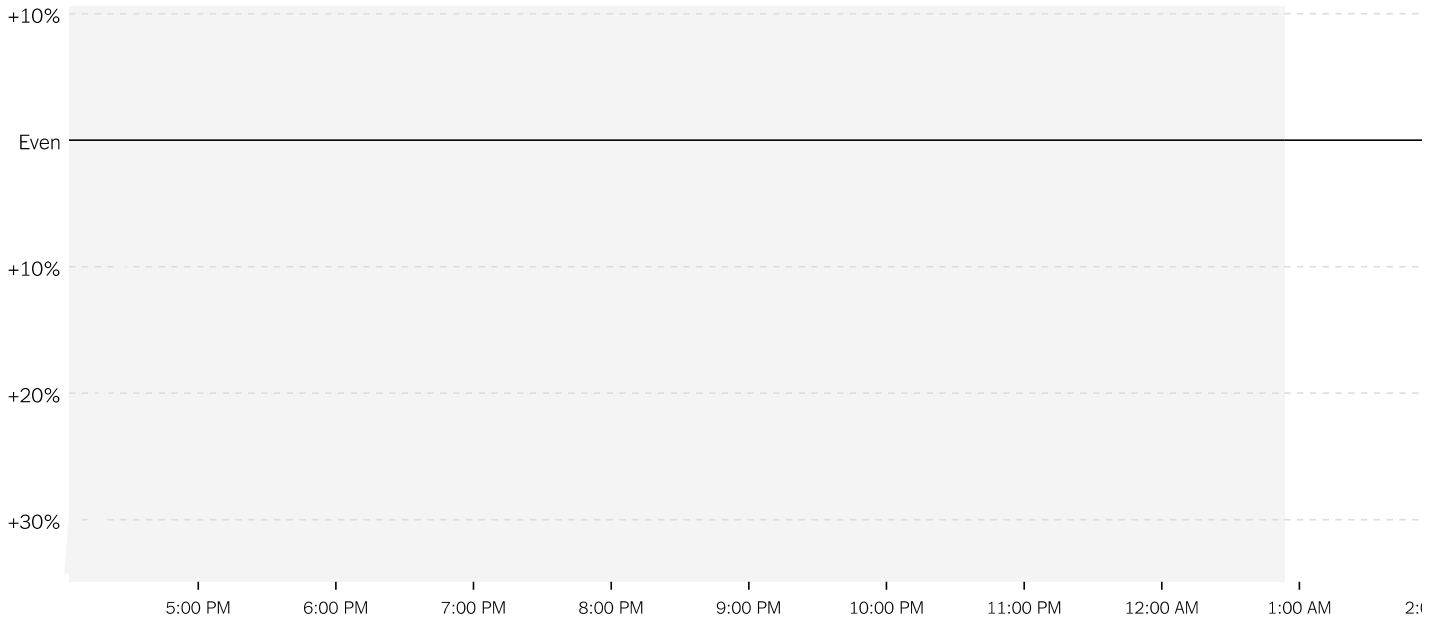

Projected Popular Vote Margin

Once a state has counted all its results, our estimated margin and the reported margin will match. As a rule, when our estimated margin is steady, our forecast is more trustworthy.
