SCHEDULE UPDATE

The Senate is expected to stand adjourned until Monday, May 4, 2020.

If the Senate needs to convene for a full session with roll call votes before May 4, Senators will receive at least 24-hours notice.

Pro forma sessions are expected to be scheduled for the weeks of April 20 and April 27.

The vote on confirmation of the nomination of Robert J. Feitel to be Inspector General of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission is expected to be moved to Monday, May 4, 2020 at 5:30 PM.

The Senate will convene at 3:00 PM for a pro forma session.

The Senate convened at 10:00 AM for a pro forma session. No business was conducted. The Senate adjourned at 10:01 AM.

The Senate convened at 10:00 AM for a pro forma session.
