Rep. Pressley Calls For "Unrest in the Streets," Targeting GOP Officials

Rep. Ayanna Pressley (D-MA) called for the targeting of Republican lawmakers and unrest in the streets during an interview on MSDNC.

"There needs to be unrest in the streets for as long as there is unrest in our lives," she said.
